- Teachers must maintain good practice in class, using effective lesson planning, addressing individual learning needs and providing constructive feedback to aid learning.
- All teachers, staff and volunteers are expected to act in a manner which maintains and enhances the good reputation of Top Hat Theatre School and support its ethics and policies at all times.
- All teachers and staff must work in a positive and cooperative manner with other individuals.
- Top Hat Theatre School will ensure that the facilities constitute a safe learning environment
- Top Hat Theatre School will promote equal opportunities.
- All teachers, staff and volunteers will ensure that private, personal and political interests do not conflict with their dealings within Top Hat Theatre School.
- All teachers and staff will deal honestly and respectfully with money, information and resources, showing courtesy towards children, parents, colleagues and visitors at all times.
- Teachers will not misrepresent their qualifications or experience.
- All teachers and staff must respect confidentiality towards children, parents and colleagues at all times.
- All students will be encouraged to discuss any problems or concerns with the Principal. Advice, support or onward referral assistance will be given where necessary
